£5 refundable deposit required for number bibs.

Rosettes to 6th place.

The course may be walked between 2pm and 5pm on Saturday the 21st
of April or on the morning of the event.

Classes 1a, 1b & 2 will be run as a Mini Arena Hunter Trial start
time **9.30 am**.

Class 1a. Rider 12 yrs & under

Class 1b. Rider 10 yrs & under (lead rein permitted)

After classes 1a & 1b are completed the arena will be available for warm up rounds at £2 per round to be collected at the entrance to arena.

Hunter Trials start time 10am

Class 2. 1'9" course	Rider 12yrs & under
Class 3. 1'9" course	Rider 16yrs & under
Class 4. 1'9" course	Novice rider any age or novice horse/pony not to have been placed 1 st or 2 nd in any hunter trial.
Class 5. 1'9" course	Open rider any age
Class 6. 1'9" course	Pairs rider any age
Class 7. 2'6" to 2'9" course	Rider 16 yrs & under
Class 8. 2'6" to 2'9" course	Novice rider any age or novice horse/pony not to have been placed 1 st or 2 nd in any hunter trial.
Class 9. 2'6" to 2'9" course	Open rider 17yrs & over
Class 10. 2'6" to 2'9" course	Pairs riders any age
Class 11. 2'6" to 2'9" course	Teams min 3 max 4

After 3 refusals at one fence competitor will be eliminated. They may continue to the next fence but must give way to the next competitor following them, except in the time section where they must exit the time section before continuing.

General rules

- Horses and ponies must be 4yrs old and over.
- Any dogs must be kept on a lead.
- Children must be supervised at all times.

- The organisers and land owners except no responsibility for anything that may happen from any cause whatsoever, to competitors, spectators, animals or property. It is a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the organisers against legal action arising from any accidents.
- Riding hats complying with the current BS standards and suitable footwear **MUST** be worn at all times when mounted. Body protectors and medical armbands are **STRONGLY** recommended.
- Do **NOT** leave horses/ponies unattended tied to the side of lorries or trailers.

The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present, for these measures to be effective everyone must take all responsible precautions to avoid accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
