Class 1a. Rider 12 yrs and under.

Class 1b. Rider 10 yrs and under. (lead rein permitted)

After classes 1a & 1b the mini arena will be open for warm up rounds at £2 per round to be collected at the entrance to the arena.

Hunter trial start time 10am

Class 2. 1"9 course Rider 12 yrs and under

Class 3. 1"9 course Rider 12 yrs and under

Class 4. 1"9 course Novice rider any age or novice horse/pony not to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any hunter trial.

Class 5. 1"9 course Open rider any age

Class 6. 1"9 course Pairs riders any age

Class 7. 2"6 to 2"9 course Rider 16yrs and under

Class 8. 2"6 to 2"9 course Novice rider any age or novice horse/pony not to have been placed in any hunter trial.

Class 9. 2"6 to 2"9 course Open rider 17yrs and under

Class 10. 2"6 to 2"9 course Pairs riders any age

Class 11. 2"6 to 2"9 course Teams min 3 max 4

After 3 refusals at one fence competitor will be eliminated. They may continue to the next fence but must give way to the next competitor, except in the time section where they must exit the time section before continuing.

General rules

- Horses must be 4yrs old or over.
- Any dogs must be kept on a lead.
- Children must be supervised at all times.
- The organisers and land owners except no responsibility for anything that may happen from any cause whatsoever, to competitors, spectators, animals or property. It is a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising from the accident.
- Riding hats complying with the current BS standards and suitable footwear **must** be worn at all times when mounted. Body protectors and armbands are **strongly** recommended.
- Do not leave horses/ponies unattended tied to the side of lorries or trailers.

The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present, for these measures to be effective everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
